1. Peterborough is the home of the McKenzie cup, named after Dr. Don McKenzie.
2. If you win the McKenzie trophy, your team's name is engraved on it and then the trophy is on display at the Peterborough Sports Hall of Fame.
3. There is a reasonably priced Friday night dinner with special guests and entertainment, prizes and gifts.
4. Teams can sell their wares at tables available at the dinner and on race day.
5. Registration is reasonable, \$700.00, with free team photos included and a guarantee of 3 races.
6. You can enjoy a private breast cancer village on the water with lunch provided.
7. Transportation is available to the race area all day.
8. Teams participate in a breast cancer ceremony organized with respect and dignity - carnations are provided for all survivors
9. The festival is an extremely well organized community event that raises funds for the local Breast Assessment Centre for diagnostic equipment.
10. Reasonable accommodation is plentiful, with the Holiday Inn right next door to the venue.
