Waiver Form

In consideration of the acceptance of my entry to participate in the International Dragon Boat Festival 2010 – Peterborough Canada for Breast Cancer Survivors (the “**Festival**”) as well as to join the practice sessions and to enter the premises, waterways and grounds (collectively, the “**Premises**”) supervised or in any way controlled by the Peterborough and District Associations of Breast Cancer Survivors operated as “Survivors Abreast Peterborough” and the International Breast Cancer Paddlers Commission (collectively, the “**Organizers**”) I do hereby forever release and discharge the Organizers and each of their respective directors, members, trustees, agents, representatives, officers, sponsors, licensors, servants, employees and volunteers and agree to indemnify and hold them harmless from and against any and all causes of action of whatsoever kind or nature arising out of or related to any loss, damage or injury including death etc. that may be sustained by me or my property for whatever reason while participating in the Festival or entering the Premises whether such loss, damage or injury is the result of negligence, breach of trust or breach of fiduciary duty on the part of the Organizers, or any other reason or cause.

I am aware, fully understand and acknowledge the risk and hazards inherent in the sport of dragon boat racing and of participating in the Festival, including its practice sessions, and entering the Premises including the area used for the purpose of launching, docking and storing equipment and I acknowledge that conditions may be hazardous and dangerous and that obstructions may exist, high winds may cause rough water and that I hereby voluntarily assume all risks of loss, damage or injury including death, that may be sustained by me or to any property while on the Premises or engaged in the Festival.

I also represent and warrant that I have sufficient medical coverage to cover my participation in the Festival and I hereby consent to receive any medical treatment, at my own expense, that may be deemed to be advisable in the event of injury and/ or illness during the Festival.

I certify that I am physically capable and fit to participate in this activity.

I consent to the publication or use in any form whatsoever of my name, image or statements or otherwise in any context pertaining to the Festival or otherwise before, during or after the Festival whether for advertising, promotion or otherwise.

I agree to read any written race briefing provided to me by the race organizers as a condition of my race entry being accepted.

This waiver shall be binding on my heirs, executors, administrators, and legal representatives.

If any provision, section, subsection, clause or phrase of this waiver is found to be unenforceable or invalid, that portion shall be severed from this waiver. The remainder of this waiver will then be construed as though the unenforceable portion had never been contained in this waiver.

I hereby declare that I am 18 years of age or older (and have provided valid proof of age) and am competent to sign this waiver.

In this waiver, the following words have the following meanings –

“**I**” means the person named below and includes that person’s heirs, executors and administrators.

“**Peterborough and District Associations of Breast Cancer Survivors**” includes its directors, officers, members, organizers, agents, contractors, sponsors, and any instrumentalities, Cities/Provinces or Councils who are involved in the conduct of the Festival.

Frequently Asked Questions - Registration

What does my entree fee include?

Your entry fee includes the following:

- On water practices sessions available and are recommended – including transport to practice sessions if required
- Opening and closing ceremonies, Saturday night gala dinner and a barbeque dinner hosted by the Mayor
- Individual identification tag
- Souvenir bag
- Souvenir program
- Lunch on both race days
- Bottled Water at race site
- Return transportation from “Official Recommended Accommodation” to race site, to opening and closing ceremonies, practices and the Saturday night gala.
- Other commemorative event items

What are the fees per paddler?

FEES are in Canadian dollars including all taxes and are:

What is the IBCPC levy?

The International Breast Cancer Paddlers Commission (IBCPC) is an organization that ensures that there are common standards for international participatory breast cancer festivals *and that these festivals and international breast cancer competitive events are raising awareness about life after a diagnosis of and treatment for breast cancer.* The levy is to provide this important organization with administrative/operational funds to carry out its mandate effectively.

What about transportation?

Transportation to and from Peterborough from home locations is an individual/team responsibility. Airport transfers will be arranged upon request at individual/team expense. The festival will provide transportation to take you from your official recommended accommodations to festival activities and return you to your accommodations.

What is the deadline for registration?

Entries close March 31, 2010 and absolutely no late entries will be accepted.

What if we don't know all of our team names in time for an early bird date?

Teams that wish to take advantage of “Early Bird” fees may pay for the number of places they require and submit names at a later date. All names must be submitted by no later than March 31, 2010.

Are there different fees for supporters?

Fees are the same whether you're a supporter or a paddling survivor. There will be at least one race for those supporters who wish to paddle.

How is breast cancer survivor defined? What if someone is at high risk and has taken preventable action, for example, had surgery for a double mastectomy and wants to participate in this event as a survivor?

For this event, a breast cancer survivor participant is someone who has been diagnosed with breast cancer. People not fitting into this definition can participate as a supporter.

Can supporters participate and how is supporter defined?

A supporter can be a partner, friend or family member of a breast cancer survivor participant. A supporter may also be a breast cancer survivor who does not wish to participate in the on-water activities.

How is team defined?

A team consists of a minimum 18 and a maximum of 26 members including drummer and steersperson (sweep). The entire team must be made up of breast cancer survivors; there are no exceptions. This includes the drummer and steersperson. Steersperson will be provided if you do not have one but we strongly suggest that you bring your own steersperson if you can since that person will be familiar with your team's paddling technique and commands and vice versa.

How does the team registration work?

A team entry is considered to be ONE Registration with at least 18 participant places booked and submitted simultaneously by the Team Liaison person.

Are substitutions allowed?

Yes, substitutions are permitted. An administrative fee of \$25.00 will be payable for each name change up to March 31, 2010. Any substitution after this date will incur a fee of \$50. No substitutions are permitted after May 31, 2010.

Is there a refund policy?

Entry fees for an entire team are not refundable under any circumstances.

Entry fees for individuals prior to January 1, 2010 are refundable, less an administrative charge of \$50 and less any bank charges. There are no refunds after January 1, 2010.
