65,000 surgical tissue samples are prepared using PDBF-funded tissue processor every year and used to confirm the presence of cancer AND when it has been successfully removed

80,000 potentially life-saving mammograms performed on PDBF-funded mammography machines since 2008

8,000 mammograms reviewed every year using new, PDBF-funded, state-of-the-art voice recognition system

15,000 + (and counting) trips that cancer patients DID NOT have to take for radiation treatment
